The painter, musician and illustrator Karl Hodina is considered a particularly versatile artist of the Austrian post-war period. Stylistically, he can be assigned to the Viennese School of Fantastic Realism, which also includes his contemporaries Ernst Fuchs and Arik Brauer. Hodina was awarded the Grand Decoration of Honor for Services to the Republic of Austria, among other honors.

His work "The Birdcatcher" was created around 1980 and captivates us with its fine brushstrokes, a tremendous richness of detail, as well as the extraordinary figure of the birdcatcher, who invites us to dive further into this enchanting picture.

The landscape, with its lush vegetation and meandering river, is inspired by Hodina's childhood in the Danube floodplains; an element that also appears in other works of the artist and radiates an extraordinary tranquility.
