



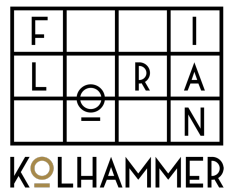

Wilhelm Bormann studied at the *Vienna School of Arts and Crafts* from 1898 and lectured at the *Vienna University of Technology*. From 1908, he was also an employee in the Viennese mosaic workshop *Leopold Forstner*. His models were presented by the *Vienna School of Arts and Crafts* at several exhibitions. The Viennese company *Goldscheider* produced several designs by Bormann.

This figure may have been executed by the *Vienna School of Arts and Crafts* around 1903. The painting is strongly reminiscent of fashion designs by Gustav Klimt.
